CHAPTER I

INTRODUCTION

A. Background of the study

There are four basic skills that students should master in studying English, they are listening, reading, writing, and speaking, and every skill has its own goal to be reached as the requirements of English mastery. The goal of writing skill is to make students able to make a good essay that is semantically and grammatically correct. Listening skill requires the students to comprehend the material through listening to direct conversation or all multimedia aids. The skill expects the students to have good ability in listening to the material and understand what they have heard. In reading skill, students are expected to have the ability to comprehend the reading passage and read well. Speaking skill focuses on the students' ability in producing English orally as good as they speak their native language.¹ In addition, Goodwin in teaching English as a second or foreign language treats the skills need for comprehension, self-expression, and monitoring.²

One of language skills that should be mastered by students is speaking. This means that everybody needs to study English. They need to speak English to practice their skill. It is useful for their future job. Bailey and

Savage in Marianne's book stated that speaking is seen as the central skill.³If they don't get used to speak English, they will have a problem in teaching English. According to Jordan, the most persistent problem for the students was the inability to express themselves adequately in the spoken language.⁴

This caseinspires the researcher to make a research about students' speaking problem.
