CONCLUSION

There are two main topics of this thesis analysis; those are Sauron's character and representation of Satan (Sauron's character) in the novel *The Lord of the Rings: the Return of the King*. Sauron is the antagonist character in the novel, he does anything what he wants without thinking of other people.
