CHAPTER V

CONCLUSION AND SUGGESTION

5.1 Conclusion

This research is about violating maxims in Johnny English Reborn the movie. The data of this research takes from the words, sentences, utterances, or expressions produced by Johnny English which violates the maxim that transcribe from the movie. This movie was directed by Oliver Parker. The movie was a British spy comedy film parodying the James Bond secret agent genre.

After obtaining and analyzing the data in the previous chapter, the researcher presents the conclusion at the last part of this paper. The conclusion was drawn based on the formulated research question. First, the types of violation of maxims were performed by the main character. The writer found all types of violating maxims that utter by the main character, Johnny English. The main character violated the maxim of quality, quantity, relation, and manner. There were twenty utterances that violated the maxims. The writer found two utterances that include of violating the maxim of quality. The next type was maxims of quantity and maxim of relation. He has eight utterances that violated the maxims of quantity and maxim of relation. And the last was violating the maxims of manner which has two utterances that violated by the main character.

Johnny English had reasons why he violated the maxims. He violated the maxims of quality because he wanted to hide the truth, saving face, convincing and building one's belief. The reason why Johnny English violated

the maxims of quantity because hide the truth, saving face, joke, convincing and building one's belief. Next, Johnny English violated the maxims of relation because hide the truth, safing face, Johnny didn't hear clearly what is being said by the master, and convincing the hearer. And the last was the reasons why the main character violated the maxims of manner, for example building one's belief and avoiding to hurt the hearer.

5.2 Suggestion

Based on the research result, the researcher would like to give some suggestions as follows:

- 1. Since the researcher difficult to look for the example of analyzing the movie, the researcher expected this research is useful as additional academic reference.
