## **CHAPTER V**

## CONCLUSION

## **5.1** Conclusion

This research is American Dialect used by Jack Bruno in 'Race to Witch Mountain' movie. Jack Bruno has strange dialect that support by other character. The dialect used by Jack Bruno is part of United Stated Exactly Southern dialect. Southern dialect is part of United Stated.

The pattern of Jack Bruno's dialect are phonological features, grammatical features, and vocabulary variation, those are:

- The pattern of southern dialect that used by the main character {Jack Bruno}
  - a. Phonological features

Jack Bruno used the phonological features such as

- 1. -*ing* ending verb + ing example: *Spendin*'.
- 2. [d] dropping in the words *don't* and [*and*].
- 3. [h] dropping only the word *How*.
- 4. [th] dropping in the words *that* and *them*.
- 5. [t] dropping, it can be in the first, middle or last word.

Example: 'hat, Bro'her, Fac'.

- 6. [be] Dropping only the word 'cause
- Vowel changing is the vowel *i* and *a* in some words changed into vowel. Example: *think*
- 8. Contracting pronunciation changed Standard English into non-

Standard Form. Example:

a. How did become *how'd* 

**b.** Gonna become *go to* 

b. Grammatical pattern

Jack Bruno also used the southern dialect in grammatical pattern such as auxiliary verb omitting, auxiliary verb changing, preposition verb omitting, ya'll, and about to.

c. Vocabulary Variation

In this term Jack Bruno shown the differences of pair's words show the differences of and the person belong to. Choosing that word is also come from the social group using that word. Jack Bruno and the Dr. Fiedman missions how gets the plane and transmit the aliens back to their world. There is only one vocabulary variation that uttered by Jack Bruno:
