CHAPTER IV

FINDINGS AND DISCUSSION

4.1 General Statement of Research Object

4.1.1 Introduction

MAN Model Bangkalan is an institution that is equal to State Senior High School in term of degree. It Islamic boarding school is developed by Indonesian Ministry of Religious Affairs. It emphasizes on good manners based on Islamic values as the prominent mission regardless of scientific thought. It drives the students to compete successfully other students from other schools in Bangkalan in several competitions they follow, even in regional level.

The achievement they obtain leads their school to be labelled as a School Model and pattern among other 5 Islamic State Senior High Schools throughout 26 provinces cannot be apart from teachers' support and motivation that are qualified and competent based on the course they have in schools. Some of them had graduated from undergraduate program and the rest are graduated from postgraduate program.

The curriculum which is applied in MAN Bangkalan are the curriculum of 2006 as a realization of law reinforcement no. 2 1989 about National Education System and government's regulations no. 29 1990

about medium level education. While 1994 curriculum applied, MAN Bangkalan open two courses; Social Science and Natural Science.

Furthermore, in the early 1998, MAN Bangkalan have been labelled as Model school. It is because MAN Bangkalan is one of school that deserve to be model of other schools in its surround based on its programs and facilities. After that, having awarded as Model school, MAN Bangkalan added one program to its main program, it was language program. Dutch Language was the first language that was taught at that time

Beside three main programs, MAN Model Bangkalan also provides various counselling and extracurricular programs to facilitate students' talents and creativity such as;

4.1.3 Achievement of Reached

MAN Model Bangkalan often reaches a lot of academic as well as on academic achievements.

a. Achievement Of Academic

MAN Model Bangkalan ever got achievement of academic in 1997-1998. In 2002-2003, MAN Model Bangkalan awarded as the best Final Term Test (Ebtanas) value for Science (IPA) program over east java and MAN Model over Indonesia. Furthermore, in 2005-2006 it reached the best ten for Final Term Test (Ebtanas) value for language program.

- Student Umi Athia got first champion of run's 5 km at HUT RI freedom into 58 in 2003.
- Third champion of modern's Islamic song (Qosidah) in Bangkalan regency level in Muharrom (Islamic month) month.
- First champion of reading texts of opening UUD 45 in Bangkalan regency level in 2006.

- 8. First champion of intelligent accurate IPTEK nuclear over Madura in 2006.
- First champion of writing working paper about Narkoba in senior high school's Bangkalan regency level in 2007.
- 10. Student Firmansyah got first champion of mathematic study in senior high school's Bangkalan regency level on 20007.
- 11. Student Mujitaba got third champion of Economic Study of Senior High school's Bangkalan regency level in 2007.
- 12. Student Qori'ah Maghfirotillah got first champion of English speech in senior high school's Bangkalan regency level in 2010.
- 13. Student Syarifatul Ulfa got third champion of English speech in senior high school's Bangkalan regency level in 2010.

4.2 Result of Research

4.2.1 Result of External Motivation and English Speaking Skill

In this section, Researcher looks firstly at external motivation and English speaking skill. In the previous chapters (chapter 3) was explained that the result of Students' English speaking skill was taken from teacher's score based on assignment mark and their performance in the class. While the result of external motivation was conducted questionnaires which were given to students.

Researcher used table to ease the calculating of product moment. Product moment method is used to know wheather there is a correlation between external motivation and English speaking skill.

Based on the result of calculation above, it is founded that there is positive correlation between external motivation and English speaking skill in MAN Model Bangkalan, since it pointed 0,190 score. According

to Marx and Hudgins³² The more external motivation students get, the better English speaking skill they have. However, in order to know whether there is significancece of coefficient correlation, it needs to be calculated with r table. Then, to have a strong realibility, researcher used 5% of standard error. According to Prof. Dr. Sugiyono if the standard error used is 5 % means the realibility standard is 95%.³³ In addition, beside using r table to conduct the correlation between external motivation and English speaking skill in MAN Model Bangkalan,

4.2.3 Discussion of Research

The correlation between external motivation and English speaking skill in MAN Model Bangkalan is very weak since it pointed 0,190 score or can say Ho push way and Ha acceptance. According to Prof. Dr. Sugiyono this number referred to weak corrolation. The Interpratation of coefficient correlation as below.
