

- b. Conduct a continuous practical guide for the students on the definition of plagiarism, the forms, and strategies for its avoidance. It is purposed especially for the lecturers of Writing 1 until 4 and the lecturers of Indonesian subject.
- c. Administer some prevention to minimize the plagiarism incidents among the students through: 1) asking the students to submit their paper assignments via e-mail. It can be easier to detect plagiarism if the paper is in the form of soft copy or file. The lecturers can directly scan the file via “dogpile” or “google” in internet to detect the plagiarisms; 2) no more extended assignment or take home paper because it widens the opportunity to plagiarize by copy-paste the sources in internet. The lecturer can administer one time subjective test in the class and decide the topic in advance for each student. It can be used as the student’s assessment and might be more reliable than take-home paper because they will use their own idea in doing their assignment; 3) habituate the students for reading, note taking, and drafting their works. In this case, the lecturer will understand the way of student’s reasoning and thinking.

3. For the department and campus

- a. Give insight for department to make patent policy on plagiarism and its consequence and also more complete guidance for writing that are applied for PBI students and lecturers. Then, it’s better to share it in a workshop attended by all the lecturers and all the students. It is aimed to make the same perceptions toward the lecturers and the students regarding the plagiarism definition, its indicators, and the rule of writing to avoid plagiarism.

- b.** The result of abovementioned suggestion will be more beneficial and useful if the department could require the lecturers to conduct a continuous practical guide for the students in the class. It is caused by the workshop of plagiarism that is conducted annually in semester 4 is not effective because of less time to drill and practice.
- c.** In fact, the plagiarism is a crime and it's identical with the character of person. Although some preventions and strategies to avoid plagiarism have been made and administered, yet it will be vain if an individual is reluctant to avoid it. Therefore, "the character building education" for the students is very important here. As the suggestion, the researcher really hopes that "character building education" could be inserted in the curriculum as the subject. Hopefully, it might give good impact to make up the character of PBI students so that the plagiarism crime could be minimized.
- d.** For the campus, the curriculum staff should make the patent policy dealing with plagiarism that can be applied for all the students and the lecturers in IAIN. It can be formed in a booklet like what other foreign universities have done and then it is shared in a seminar. Moreover, the advance of technology makes everything easier. Many sophisticated plagiarism detection tools are available now such as "*Turnitin*". It's a peer-check/cross-campus for assignments. Any plagiarism incidents in students' or lecturers' assignments can be easily detected through this tool. Therefore, the researcher really recommends the
