

CHAPTER IV

CONCLUSION

This chapter concludes the discussion in the previous chapter. The answer of the problem in this study is explained in the following. The factor that influence John to become *Muallaf* is John's personality. As discussed before, before John becomes a Muslims, he is an agnostics and disbelief and after John becomes a Muslim, he belief in God. John has several characteristics they are dutiful, honest, and responsible. Those characteristics have contribution to shape him as a *Muallaf* and makes him feel compatible with Islamic teaching.

The first, John is a dutiful man. It can be seen from the way he obeys what his parent says and he obeys what his mentor ask for. Also it can be seen when he lived in Indonesia, he obeys the rules and follows Indonesian law and culture. The second, John is an honest man. John's words and his deeds are in accordance with the truth such as, when he knows the truth that is contained in The Holy Quran, he cannot deceive himself to not believe it because John is saying truthfully that Quran is logical and sensible. The last, John is responsible. It can be seen when he decides to take for living with Amy and he is willing to work hard to suffice their need. Before the writer finds out about the effects of John's personality in becoming *Muallaf*, the writer examines John's id, ego, and superego.
