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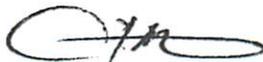
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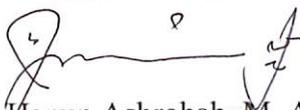
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it down into Indonesian language. The third, their motivation in learning English was also still low.

Then, the result of preliminary study at the first grade of SMA HANG TUAH 2 SIDOARJO shows that the students' achievement in writing class is not good. There are some students who have good writing competence in the classroom. Based on the statement above, the researcher is interested in choosing this school as the object of his research. The researcher wants to help the students to improve their writing competence.

The English teacher of SMA HANG TUAH 2 SIDOARJO has implemented the cooperative games before. Although, there was no researcher who concern to observe those cooperative games. Cooperative games implemented to make the students mind fresh only, there was no the specific goal except to refresh students mind after studying the lesson. And, there was no exact assessment to measure the students' development after playing the cooperative games.

Based on the explanation above, this study would concern about the use of cooperative games in teaching news item text of writing skills in senior high school to improve students' ability in writing skill. He chooses this way in order to describe: a) the implementation of cooperative games, b) to describe students' responses after implementing the cooperative games, c) to describe the classroom atmosphere during the cooperative games held, d) to progress students' writing ability after cooperative games are implemented.





























2. Cooperative learning addresses content area learning and language development needs within the same organizational framework. The effect of combining language learning may be multiple active rather than simply additive. For instance, emphasizing prosocial behavior addresses important language functions while increasing content. And, since it is done within a meaningful, highly motivated context, within an instrumental and referential environment, the language functions may be learned more effectively than through traditional direct teaching methods.
3. The variety of ways to structure student practice with lesson material increases opportunities for individualized instruction, such as peer provided clarifications. As a result, lesson objectives may be achieved more rapidly and more efficiently. The increased quantity and quality of communication apparently bring more benefit than the 'risk' the students may receive incorrect information or input non-standard varieties of language. Nonnative English speakers show gains in academic achievement and in language acquisition either equivalent or superior to gains through direct whole class teaching.

### **3. Characteristic of cooperative learning**

The interaction may be as simple as having students discuss points of a lecturer in pairs or they may be a complex, based on precise grouping, grading, or specialized tasks. Not all of group work or informal collaboration between

students is a cooperative. Cooperative learning is distinctive because it may include attention to the positive interdependence, team formation, and accountability, attention to social skills, structures and structuring. Below is the characteristics of cooperative games:

- 1) Positive interdependence: means that one individual is associated with other. When one student achieves, other students as well.
- 2) Team formation means that students or teacher can assign the group. But, the most important thing to do in this characteristic is the groups are designed before and include of heterogonous students.
- 3) Accountability, students may be made individually accountable by assigning each student a grade on his or her own portion of the team project or by the rule that the group may not go on to the next activity until all team members finish the task. A primary way to ensure accountability is trough testing.
- 4) Social skill means ways of students to interact each other to achieve activity or task objectives such as asking and explaining. And students' ways interact with their teammates such as praising or recognizing. Social skill can be emphases by assigning.









































Ideally, teacher should approach every evaluation as if they were readers encountering the work for the first time; teacher should give the possible and appropriate reading in their work. The evaluation of students' writing usually begins with response by writing a comment on a draft, students and teacher conferring, and teacher intervention in the classroom. The major objective of such evaluates responses is to focus on how to help the students solve their problem by giving some specific advice that is honest but never cruel or sarcastic.















#### **4. Observing**

This observation has done to identify the classroom activities during the teaching and learning process. It has done while the action is being implemented. Observation and field notes are helping the researcher to do observation. The result of observation can be input to the observer in the next meeting in order to make the teaching and learning process better than the first cycle.

#### **5. Reflecting**

Reflection is included with analysis which has been done from the planning until the observing of teaching and learning process. And, feedback included in this section. The result of the reflecting can be input in next cycle to prepare the material, time allocations, and other weakness in order to do the best in the next cycle.

### **E. Data Collection Technique**

In this study, the researcher uses two ways to collect the data, they are:

#### **1. Observation**

Observation is an evaluation by observing to the objects directly, accurately and systematically.<sup>2</sup> Its can be about the situation of teaching and learning process when the observer implements the cooperative games

The sample texts set out in tables 1 and 2 illustrated the way in which these criteria applied to analysis the generic structure. The generic structure was about news item. The schematic structure of which was as follows;

1. **Newsworthy event** : Recounts (tells) the even in summary form.
2. **Background event** : Elaborate what happened, to whom, in what, circumstances.
  - a. Where did it happen?
  - b. When did it happen?
  - c. Who were involved in the event?
  - d. Why did it happen?
  - e. How did it happen?
3. **Source** : Comment usually given by:
  - a. Participants
  - b. Witness
  - c. Authorities
  - d. Expert on the event

writes down what was the students write. And the students should give their written text to other students. Someone who got the paper should read it loudly and other students listens it. The class was very noisy when the student who reads other students writing text, because sometime they write down about their boy or girl friend, and their secret.

While writing activity, the teacher divided the students into small groups consisting 3-4 students to discuss and make news according to the group agreement. Then, the teacher combined the group that had same news and the new group consist 6-7 students. They discussed about the news they have chosen and the next make the news. After finished the work in their group, they wrote down the list of question on a piece of paper then throw it to other group. The group who got the paper should answer and throw it again the group before.

To check their understanding, the teacher gave an Individual work of the same news. They did it directly, students who did not finish it yet could do it at home and collect to next meeting.

Giving feed back to the students and checking their understanding about the material had done in closing activity. In this session the teacher give a chance to the students to ask the point they did not understand.

cycle was held on 7 May 2009. Based the result of the reflecting of the first cycle the teacher found that he should controlling the time allocation in order to make the students played the next game effectively. Next was motivating the students to Use English during the teaching and learning process. Then, Giving reward or punishment to what the students did tough they make mistake or not. This act could stimulate them to be better. After that, controlling the students when they play the game in they group. Then, explaining the technique of the game more clearly and describing the scoring of their writing ability in order to make them more serious to use their writing ability. Not only controlling the students when they play the games, but also Controlling the students' interaction and observing the students' motion when they playing the game. And the last of the first reflecting was motivating them to write and explaining the mistake in their written text. If it was necessary correction should be done directly if only the message was not assessable during the game.

Based on the progress of students' writing ability in the first meeting, the result of their writing was still low because they confused about the generic structure and the games' roles. Besides that, they were very noisy especially when the teacher forming the group and when they playing the game. There was one student who got B grade because she got 81 point. Fourteen students got C grades because their point between 70-80, twenty students got D grades because their point was about 60-70 point, and four students got F grades because they got less than 60 point.

The second cycle was held on 14 May 2009. According to the reflecting of this cycle, the teacher should be aware of controlling the students' interaction and observing the students' motion. Besides that, motivating them to write and participate in the cooperative game. And the last was giving reward or punishment to what the students did though they make mistake or not. It could stimulate them to be better. In this cycle, most of students were active in participating the cooperative games because they did not confuse the role anymore. But, the students sometimes very noisy especially when they interact each other.

Based on the progress of the students' writing ability, this cycle was better than the first cycle. It caused by students' understanding about the game roles and they had got the cooperative game in the first cycle so they had more spirit to do the games. Besides that, the topic was up to date. It was about *Antasari case*. According to they written task, there were twelve student got **B** grade because they got the point between 89 and 80 point, twenty five of students got **C** grades because their point between 70-80, and five students got **D** grades because their point was about 60-70 point.

The next cycle was held on 23 May 2009. Based the reflecting of this cycle, the teacher should consider about motivating them to write more cooperatively in their group. And, explain the scoring criteria in order to make them stimulate them to be better. Based on this cycle, the students' writing progress generally rwasing up then the second cycle, although it was not

significant. It was proven by their writing score, the grades of their writing according to ESL were one student in grade A, ten students in B grade because they got the point between 89 and 80 point, twenty eight of students got C grades because their point between 70-80, and two students got D grades because their point was about 60-70 point.

The forth cycle was held on 28 May 2009, according to the reflection of this cycle, these was about motivating the students to use English during the teaching and learning process. And, giving reward or punishment to what students did although they make mistake or no. it could stimulate them to be better.

After the whole cycle implemented and considered the reflecting of every cycle the teacher concludes that the students could do the cooperative games cooperatively. Although, it was noisy especially in forming the group on the first meeting. But, the teacher could solve it in the next cycle. The students' writing progress also showed the development in every cycle. It was proven by the score and the grades they had gotten.









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
