CHAPTER IV

FINDING AND DISCUSSION

This chapter is presents the answered section of the statement of problem in this research. The writer finds the register used by characters in *Shooter* movie. Then analyzes the data based on Wardhaugh and Halliday's theory about the use of register and the categories of register especially in *Shooter* community. After finding the register the writer tries to know the meaning of those register and classified into parts of speech. Then the writer identifies the categories of register used by characters in the movie.

The writer presents the data which is taken from *Shooter* movie. Then identified the data, the data will show the new vocabularies which are considered as the register used by characters in *Shooter* movie. In this movie the writer finds 21 unique vocabularies. Moreover, the writer explains the register found there; explain the meaning (literal or non – literal meaning) after that classified into parts of speech with the further explanation in order to get the data accurately, and explain the categories of register

Then, the result of register is stated in 21 unique vocabularies. Then those unique vocabularies are classified into parts of speech form and explain in its meaning (literal or non – literal meaning).

1.1 Register Used by Characters in Shooter Movie

In this discussion the writer uses Wardhaugh theory, registers are sets of language items associated with different occupational or social groups such as surgeons, airline pilots, bank managers, sales clerks, jazz fans, and computer community (Wardhaugh, 2006). It means register is variant of language used in the particular jobs as communities to describe the specific vocabulary associated with different occupational groups or social group. The writer found the answer of the first statement of problem in this study, there are 21 registers used by characters in *Shooter* movie.

Those register had the meaning which related to shooter community. Shooter community is a community of army in United State which consists of people who have great shooting ability. In *shooter* movie, the characters show their identity with their language. That language or register as marker identity. They use their register to reinforce their identity as army. John said that the importance of language as an identity marker at group level is much more readily evident that everyone is used to accent, dialect and language variation that reveal speaker's memberships in particular speech communities social classes, ethnic ad national group (John, 2009).

The characters of *shooter* movie create a communication among his partnership and his captain during doing their job. The communication that they are talking about relates to their job as army in United State. In this movie, the writer finds 21 new vocabularies. A kind of register which is appearing in the *shooter* movie is in the type of specific terms or vocabularies used in the main communication by characters in *Shooter* movie. The registers are: *T-129, Viper, CP, Sector Bravo, 675, 920, Three-quarter value, Coriolis effect, Static, 44* magnum, Yellow ribbons, 17, 15, 419, Condor two, Ballistic, 22, 15-foot, perimeter, 732, 643, Plutonium, and Osmotic.

4.1.2 The Meaning of Register Used by Characters in Shooter Movie

In the second of statement of problem, the characters of *shooter* movie use technical term to make their job easily done. The terms are not easily understood by people outside this group except United States army. All of register used by the characters in the movie had meaning. Meaning divided into two, they are literal and non-literal meaning. Literal meaning shows a meaning as it is written in a language. For example, in the sentence "I am hungry", it can be understood well directly that the speaker was hungry.

While Saeed state that non literal meaning shows a mean indirectly. For example, in the sentence "I could eat a horse", it does not mean that the speaker would really eat a horse. It means that the speaker were really in hunger. Non literal uses of language are traditionally called figurative and are described by a host of rhetorical term including metaphor, irony, metonymy, synecdoche, hyperbole and litotes (Saeed, 2003). After knowing each meaning of those register, the writer will classify into parts of speech. Part of speech classified into eight, there are noun, verb, adjective, adverb, pronoun, preposition, conjunction, and article (Verspoor, Marjoljn and Kim Sauter, 2007).

These are kinds of registers used by characters in *shooter* movie. The data below will be explained the meaning of those registers and classified into parts of speech.

From conversation above there are three registers TS - 129, viper, and CP used by the mission group (Swagger and Donnie) and FBI's leader. Those registers have literal meaning TS-129 (T: one of the alphabet, 129: one hundred twenty nine), Viper (A poisonous snake found in Africa, Asia and Europe), CP (Chat post) Three of those register are noun. Three of those register have non-literal meaning too, like TS-129 has non-literal meaning (The name of mission Army group. This mission group consist of swagger and Donnie), viper (Used to call the enemy in *Shooter* community), and CP (Used to inform to FBI's member). Then, in this conversation the mission group of Army consists of Swagger and Donnie convey the information to command post; they have in their position. Then the command post got CP, it is convey the information: there are viper will attack in the TS-129 position at 12.00.

The conversation contains register *sector bravo*. It has literal meaning (Sector: any of the parts of a battle area or of an under military control, bravo: a shout of approval, especially to an actor, singer etc. bravo! Well!). It represent noun, Sector bravo which consist of noun namely "sector" and "bravo". The content of this conversation occur when Donnie and Swagger still in the TS-129, they find their enemy in the sector bravo by vehicle and brought gun. Swagger asked Donnie to prepare the range of shot like: 870 yard, wind three quarter value, push 2 left. Donnie said *sector bravo* because that area is specific which excite to shot the enemy.

From the conversation by character above, it founded register *viper*, *sector bravo*, 675, 900, 920, and *three quarter value*. Those registers has literal meaning such as: (*Sector*: any of the parts of a battle area or of an under military control, *bravo*: a shout of approval, especially to an actor, singer etc. bravo! Well!), (675: six hundreds seventy five, 920: nine hundreds twenty), (*Three quarter*: three quarters of the size or the whole, *value*: the quality of being useful or important). All of those register are noun, except *three quarter value*," three quarter" represent adjective and "value" is noun then three quarter value represent noun phrase. Then this conversation Swagger and Donnie have shot their enemy in the TS-129. Usually in the *shooter* community before they shoot their viper, they must prepare the range of shoot like 920, 675 and when they want to know the position to machine gun they only say three quarter value. Then, they can shoot in the specific area it calls sector bravo. This community always uses viper word to call their enemy.

Swagger said *Cartoles Effect*. It represents noun and this conversation happened after Swagger decides to retreat in shooter community. After that, Colonel Johnson came to Swagger's house. Johnson asks him to kill the president because there is no person who has great shooting ability except Swagger. Then Swagger explains about everything which is influence with the range of shot, like: humidity, elevation, temperature, wind, spindrift and carioles effect. *Carioles effect* used to know the large scale aerial movement and atmosphere.

From the statement above shows the register is *ballistic*. It has literal meaning (The study of things that are shot or fired through the air). The word ballistic represents noun, it is kind of register in shooter community. In this

statement happen after Johnson come to his house, Swagger called his friend. He entrust his favorite dog to his friend because he wants do his mission from Johnson. Swagger looks for place where president will shoot. Swagger noticed to his friend "one day please read a few ballistic tables to my dog if he looks lonely". From that sentence, not only Swagger understands about ballistic but also his favorite dog.

The word *static, ballistic* and *44 magnum* are register. *Static, ballistic* and *44 magnum* are represent noun, because *static* has meaning (Conditions in the atmosphere causing pool sound or picture quality on radio or television, marked by loud harsh noises), *ballistic* (The study of things that are shot or fired through the air), and *44 magnum* (A bottle containing 1,5 liters of wine or spirits). In the contrary, *static* and *44 magnum* have non-literal meaning, this conversation

happen, when Swagger had look for the place to shoot the president. There are three places such as Baltimore, Washington DC and Philly. Swagger told to Johnson that shot will be taken from Philly. It is one of possible location to shoot the Baltimore and Washington DC, because in the Philly approximately five storeys above the president's location. Flight time of the bullet that distance is five to six seconds and the bullet's going to strike with more energy. Than *44 magnum has literal meaning*, magnum is handgun it guns has big damage.

In the conversation shows the register *yellow ribbons*. It represents noun phrase (*yellow ribbons*), *yellow ribbons* which consist of an adjective, namely "*yellow*" and noun namely "*ribbons*". It has literal meaning "something for decoration which has color like lemon or butter". In this conversation Swagger after know the place will shoot the president, Swagger make cooperation with FBI's member to keep Philly's area. Before shooting Swagger asks Sergeant about *yellow ribbons*, "Does he know about *yellow ribbons*?" in fact, he does not. Then Swagger informed to him about it. It is wind flags. Swagger put there because it is sign of shot from the steeple.

This statement shows the register *condor two*. It represents noun and it has literal meaning "type of vulture or eagle found in America". This statement happen after Swagger does his mission to shoot the president, but here he traps by Johnson and his subordinates. The goal is not president but Archbishop of Ethiopia. After that, Swagger run away from that area and group FBI pursued Swagger by helicopter. FBI supposed Swagger who shot Archbishop of Ethiopia. In fact, person who shot Archbishop of Ethiopia is Timmon. Timmon is Johnson subordinate. In this community condor is a group of FBI who used helicopter.

From the conversation above, the member of FBI and Ed used register. The register *17* and *15*, both of them represent noun. *15* and *17* mean the fifteen and seventeen post. After Swagger run away from that area. The member of FBI makes communication with his partner he asks the situation of that area, but there post is there is no activity at their location.

We are transitioning from roadhouse to Front Street.
Please, advise for further description of suspect vehicle.
Dispatch, <u>419</u> , I'm heading south on Thompson.
Do we have a color, anything on the vehicle?

The conversation shows the register 419. It means type of FBI helicopter. It represent noun. This conversation happened between Ed in the FBI office and member of FBI which on helicopter. The type of helicopter who use by FBI group pursued Swagger is 419. That helicopter pursued black car which drives by Swagger. The black car is Nick car which stole by him Swagger run away from Philly with that car. It has licenses number 7 - 3 - 1 - 7.

Nick shows the register *osmotic*. It has literal meaning "One of the solution characteristic". It represent adjective. Nick who have black car, it has licenses number 7 - 3 - 1 - 7. Then his car stole by Swagger to escape from Philly. In this conversation Nick gets information about Swagger. Swagger buys salt, sugar, water and marinade injector to maintain the body because he has shoot by Timmon. Then Nick explained to his boss about function all of Swagger buy in that shop, especially sugar can to treat battlefield wounds for hundreds years, but his boss still angry because he supposed Nick makes cooperation with Swagger. In this community *osmotic* means "the pressure needed to maintain the body balance"

Sergeant shows the register 22. It represent noun. It means types of Swagger gun. Nick get warning from the center because Swagger allowed by his car. Then Nick in difficult position, after knowing Swagger uses Nick car. Johnson asks his subordinates to kidnap and torture Nick. After that, Senator and Johnson talk in the living room, they heard there is a person who saves Nick from Johnson's hand. That person used 22 gun. 22 it means type of Swagger gun. Swagger saved Nick with successfully. Then Swagger asked Nick to make cooperation with him to kill Johnson and his subordinates.

In this conversation Swagger said 15- foot. It represent noun. Nick saved by Swagger. Both of them make cooperation to kill Johnson, his subordinate and Senator In the wide plain Swagger and Nick assembled the gun to kill Johnson, Sergeant and their group. Swagger says to him about that gun. It can kill 15 foot. It means not only foot will kill but also his body of fifteen people can kill by that gun.

From the conversation shows *perimeter* as register. It represents noun and literal meaning from perimeter is a boundary around an area. In this community Perimeter means a boundary where guide must alert there. Guide must keep in that area. This conversation occurred when Swagger and Nick did their mission in front of sergeant's house. Swagger killed sergeant's member one by one. Then he entered to inside sergeant's house. Swagger came here because he has purpose, he wanted know about "the real Johnson's name and he work for whom?" but Sergeant did not answer it.

Swagger said 732 and 648. It shows register and represent noun. The mission of Swagger and nick were successful. Johnson knows about it. After that, Swagger called Johnson. He wanted meet Johnson at 732 or 648. Those numbers

mean swagger will meet Johnson and senator in this area. This area is ice desert and the last of three digits down to a few meters of latitude and longitude.

The conversation above occurs between Nick and Swagger in the ice desert. The dialogue contains register *plutonium*. It has literal meaning "Chemical element". It represent noun (*plutonium*). The content of the dialogue is Swagger reminds to Johnson and Senator, if one of them betrays the principles of the accrual he wants give them plutonium because nobody can handle it without dying. Plutonium here means it used especially in nuclear weapons and as a fuel in nuclear power situation and it has big damage. Those data above can be evidence which in the *shooter* community use language represent as register.

Moreover, register used by characters in *shooter* movie have non literal meaning, non-literal uses of language are traditionally called figurative and are described by a host of rhetorical term including metaphor, irony, metonymy,

synecdoche, hyperbole and litotes. For example of metaphor in this community, when this community called their enemy, they used "viper". Literal meaning of viper is a poisonous snake found in Africa, Asia and Europe. Enemy in this community is like viper. Then every people who meet the enemy in this community, they called viper.

In other word, this community say "condor". It means group of FBI which uses helicopter. In literal meaning condor has meaning a type of vulture or eagle found in America. Eagle or vulture bird is flying. Then the group of FBI who by helicopter called condor.

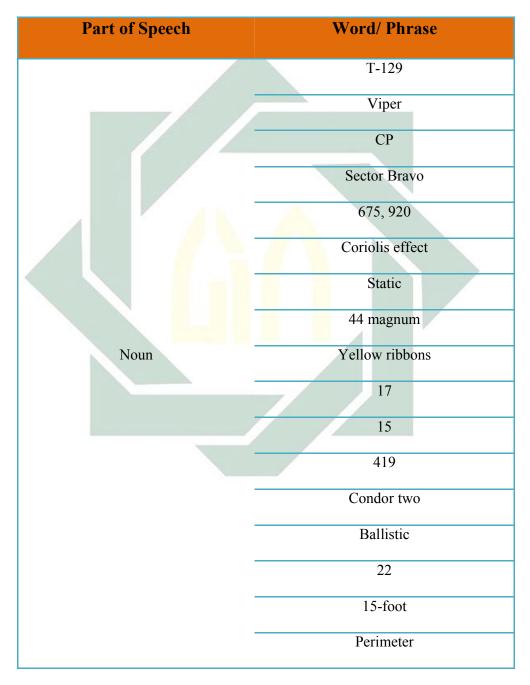
Then, Yellow ribbons has literal meaning, from the word "yellow" is the color of lemon or butter while "ribbons" is silk, nylon or other material in a narrow strip used for tying something or for decoration. However in this community, when Swagger says to his friend about yellow ribbons, it means wind flags. It is sign to shoot from the steeple.

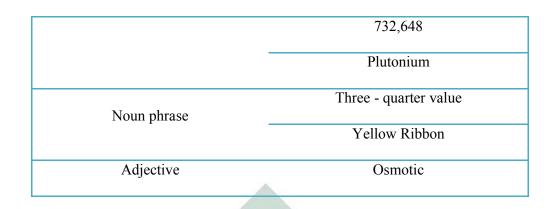
44 magnums has literal meaning. 44 means forty and magnum means a bottle containing 1, 5 liters of wine or spirit. In non-literal meaning it means name of handgun and it has big damage. Who can 44 magnum in their body they get big damage like die.

Then synecdoche is a literary deice in which a part of something represent the whole or it may use a whole to represent a part, for example from shooter community, when Swagger and Nick assembled the gun to kill Johnson, Sergeant and their group. Swagger say to that gun can kill 15 foot. It means not only foot

will kill but also his body of fifteen people can kill by that gun. That about non literal meaning of register used by characters in *shooter* movie.

After knowing the meaning of those registers then, the writer classified into part of speech. There are 18 noun, 2 noun phrase and 1 adjective.





4.1.3 The Categories of Register Used by Characters in the Movie

The third statement of problem in this study can be answered by Halliday's theory. The linguist Michael Halliday register divided into three categories: field, tenor and mode. Those categories happened in register used by character in *shooter* movie.

The writer found register used by characters in *shooter* movie. They used register in certain matter and purpose. The explanations of each categories of register are explained below.

4.1.3.1 Field

The first categories is field, it involves the setting in which communication takes place and what language is being used to talk about. In *shooter* movie the character used technical or specialized term such as they used language that people do not know the meaning is.

The data below are supported the answer of the third statement of this study. It is about field of register categories used in *shooter* movie.

From the first data, Donnie and Swagger talked about shooter situation. When they did their mission of Army, Donnie told to Swagger that he knew enemies. Their enemies were front of them. The first enemy was over the top, second was down the river and tertiary were to the river. The setting of the first data is in the top and down the river.

Then the second data, Johnson came to Swagger house. Johnson asked Swagger to shoot their president. After that Swagger talked about the range of shoot, "what were we need when we wanted to shoot from far?", he gave know to

Johnson that everything comes into play far are Humidity, elevation, temperature, wind, spindrift. Even the Coriolis Effect, the spin of the Earth comes into play. The setting of the second data is about the factor that influence the distance of shot like: Humidity, elevation, temperature, wind, spindrift and the Coriolis Effect.

It explained about field used in *shooter* movie. Shooter community used technical term, the term are not easily understood by people outside this group except shooter community.

4.1.3.2 Tenor

The second category is tenor. It indicates the role relationship between the speaker and addressee. Tenor refers to who is talking part in the situation. The notion of tenor highlights the way in which linguistic choices are affected not just by the topic or subject matter of communication but also by the kind of social relationship within which communication taking place (Montgomery, 1989).

Then Halliday stated the relationship between the speaker and the addressee varies according to:

- a. status (ranging from unequal as in the case of a boss to employee and equal as friend to friend)
- b. affective involvement (ranging from high as with friends/family members or with business clients)
- c. Contact (ranging from frequent as people who frequently meet you and occasional as people who rarely meet you).

The relationship between the speaker and addressee influences the formality of the language used. Tenor is one of the register categories, it happens in *shooter* movie. The data below are supported the answer of the statement of the study. It is about tenor.

Unequal status can influence the using language, for example of this conversation between Nick as employee with his boss. Nick talked to his boss with formal language. The content of this conversation is Nick give know to his boss that Swagger still life, he buy salt, sugar, water and marinade injector for Swagger's injury. Nick explains to his boss about the purposes of those substances, but his boss is angry. He does not listen what Nick said. And he asks Nick to go back to Nick's desk.

4.1.3.3 Mode

The third category is mode. It refers to what the role language is playing in interaction. It includes in the medium of communication matters such as spoken or written or its combination between written to be spoken or spoken to be written. Language can be spontaneous or planned.

The result of analyzing the data of this study shows that the categories of register in *shooter* movie is also including in the categories of mode because the

level of their conversation in spoken form made their communication be more specific. They used language spontaneously in their conversation.
