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In short, Vercellotti's research and this research were similar in the use of fluency and accuracy in speaking performance. However, Vercellotti focused only to the development and relation among CAF while this study centered the study on the implication of speaking class in university students. Since both researches employ qualitative research in speaking is identical element between them.

A journal entitled "Japanese English: Fluency and Accuracy in the Spoken English of High School Learners" by Ano.<sup>31</sup> In his journal, he investigated the relation of fluency and accuracy in the spoken English of high school learners. This study tests two hypothesis; the first is whether The total number of words, the number of silent pauses, the number of repetition, the number of repair and Mean Length of Utterance (MLU) have a negative correlation with each other, while the second is whether fluency and accuracy in the speech samples of high school learners has a positive because the five variables relations among each variable have positive correlations. Beside

which affect their English speaking and make them reticent learners. Then, by participating in every English speaking activity both inside and outside the class, students can contribute to their language learning process.

Based on above previous studies, they have correlations and differences to this research. The preceding undergraduate thesis and dissertation were different from this research. The first one only implemented fluency in speaking toward senior high school students, and the second is the development and relation among CAF which is strongly different since it did not analyze the real class situation. The first journal concerns to the relation between fluency and accuracy. Meanwhile, Dincer, et.al, investigates fluency and accuracy as element to promote speaking in Foreign Language Classroom in Senior High school level. They are different from this research which focuses on the investigation of the implication of fluency and accuracy in speaking class of university students.

Briefly, four researches above could not answer this research questions, so it is implied that it is required to do the research about fluency and accuracy in spoken English of EFL learners; implications for classroom practice in Speaking for Formal Setting which is investigated toward university students.
