## IMPLICATURES FOUND IN VARIOUS SELECTED ENGLISH SONG LYRICS AND THE LISTENER'S RESPONSES OF THE SONGS

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#### **ABSTRACT**

Keywords: song lyrics, Gricerian Implicature, types of Implicature

This thesis aims to seek and analyze the Implicature and the types of Implicature found in the selected song lyrics and the listener's responses. The data in this thesis were collected from the selected song lyrics from various artists obtained from Google by searching on it and the listener's responses found in the comment under the selected song's music video on Youtube. In this study, the researcher uses Gricerian Implicature theory as the theoretical framework, which provides about Implicature definition and the types of Implicature (Generalized CI, Particularized CI, Conventional Implicature, and Scalar Implicature).

This study uses a descriptive qualitative method to analyze the data. The descriptive study in the textual analysis was applied in this thesis to analyze the utterance/song lyrics of the selected song lyrics. The data were collected by first searching the song lyrics from various artists on Google and then searching the listener's responses in the comment section of the selected song's music video on Youtube. The song lyrics were then analyzed by identifying the implicatures of each utterance in the song lyrics. The analysis continued by analyzing the Implicature and categorizing the types of Implicature of the listener's responses. And the last, the analysis continued by identifying the types of Implicature of the selected song lyrics.

This study results that all of the types of Implicature are found in the selected song lyrics and also in the listener's responses. The most frequent types that found after analyzed the song lyrics and the listener's responses are Generalized conversational Implicature and Particularized conversational Implicature.

Penelitian ini bertujuan untuk mencari dan menganalisis implikatur dan tipe-tipe implikatur yang ditemukan pada lirik lagu terpilih dan respon-respon pendengar. Data pada penelitian ini dikumpulkan dari lirik-lirik lagu terpilih dari berbagai penyanyi yang didapatkan dari Google dengan mencarinya dan respon dari pendengar yang ditemukan pada komentar dibawah music video lagu yang terpilih di Youtube. Pada penelitian ini, peneliti menggunakan teori implikature Grice sebagai kerangka teori yang mana memberikan penjelasan tentang implikatur dan tipe- tipe implikatur.

Penelitian ini menggunakan metode deskriptif kualitatif untuk menganalisis data. Penelitian deskriptif dalam analisis tekstual diterapkan dalam penelitian ini untuk menganalisis ungkapan/lirik lagu dari lirik lagu yang terpilh. Data dikumpulkan dengan terlebih dahulu mencari lirik lagu di Google and kemudian mencari respon pendengar pada bagian komentar di music video lagu yang terpilih di Youtube. Lirik-lirik lagu kemudian dianalisis dengan mengidentifikasi implikatur pada tiap ungkapan pada lirik lagu. Analisis dilanjutkan dengan menganalisis implikatur dan tipe-tipe implikatur dari respon pendengar. Dan terakhir, analisis dilanjutkan dengan mengidentifikasi tipe-tipe implikatur dari lirik lagu yang terpilih.

Penelitian ini menunjukkan bahwa semua tipe implikatur ditemukan pada lirik-lirik lagu yang terpilih dan juga pada respon-respon pendengar. Tipe yang paling sering ditemukan setelah menganalisis lirik-lirik lagu dan respon pendengar adalah Generalized conversational implikatur dan Particularized conversational implikatur.

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#### **CHAPTER I**

#### **INTRODUCTION**

#### 1.1 Background of Study

Implicature is a topic in the scope of Pragmatics and Discourse

Analysis that discusses the implied meaning of an utterance. Implicature is something beyond what the speakers literally say or it can be said as a distinct meaning of an utterance. According to Grice (cited in Brown and Yule, 1983, p.31), the term "implicature" can be interpreted as what the speakers of an utterance can suggest or imply as different from what the speaker literally says. Implicature is the study that includes the interpretation of what individuals mean in a very particular context and the way the context affects what is said by the individuals. Implicature aims to make language wider than the word meaning and to express an additional meaning of utterance which should not only have explicit meaning but also implicit meaning.

Nowadays, music cannot be separated from people's life. Music has become part of everyone's life. Everyone can easily listen to music through several media such as radio, television, computer, smartphone, and many more. There are various music platforms to listen to music such as Spotify, Apple Music, JOOX, Youtube music, etc. As the music or song develops throughout the years, there are a lot of songs that have beautiful and unique lyrics to attract the

listener. The lyrics contain messages that are directly conveyed to the listeners and the lyrics replace the traditional ways to convey the message to one another.

Lyrics are the combination of words that build up a song and it usually consists of choruses and verses. Nowadays the lyricists are competing to create beautiful and meaningful song lyrics.

These days, a lot of people listen to songs that have lyrics that can relate to their life and to their problems such as love issues, social issues, etc. After listening to the songs, people usually give feedback or responses regarding the quality of the song, the meaning of the lyric, and how the song lyrics relate to their life.

There have been a number of studies that have analyzed the Implicature, especially conversational Implicature. Siregar (2018) conducted research that analyzed conversational in V for Vendetta movie. Another study was conducted by Huda (2013) which analyzed conversational Implicature found in the Dialogue of Euro Trip movie. The researcher used Grice's Cooperative Principle and its maxims. The researcher stated that the main objective of his research is to find out how utterance can be different from its literal meaning by analyzing the flouting maxim that happened in the Dialogue of Euro Trip movie. Nurzani (2015) investigated the conversational Implicature in English Zone Course Book for senior high school students in year XI. The researcher adapted the implicature theory by George Yule, Levinson, and Cooperative principles by Grice to analyze the data.

In a similar study of Implicature, Hidayah (2018) analyzed Implicature found in several advertisements that the researcher had chosen. The main objective of this research is to find the implicatures implied by the advertisement and find the contrast implicature in the selected advertisements. In this research, the researcher used the qualitative research method by employed content analysis to explore more about the data. The researcher used Gricerian Implicature theory to analyze the data. In the process, the researcher divided the ten advertisements based on their category. The researcher found the implicatures that were implied in each advertisement and the contrast between them.

Husna (2013), as another example, did research about an implicature analysis on "Oh, Brother!" comic strip serials. The main objective of this research is to analyze the comic using Gricerian Implicature theory and Griceian cooperative principles. The researcher employs a descriptive qualitative method to analyze the data. The result shows that there are 45 implicatures which divide into three. They are one conventional Implicature, 36 conversational implicatures, and eight scalar implicatures. The researcher also found several types of violations of maxim.

Nurzani (2015) investigated the conversational Implicature in English Zone Coursebook For Senior High School Student year XI. This research aims to analyze the types of conversational Implicature used in the English Zone Coursebook. The researcher used descriptive qualitative as the method to analyze the data. The researcher adapted the implicature theory by George Yule and Levinson and Cooperative principles by Grice to analyze the data. There are two

findings in this research. The first is the types of Implicature that found in the Coursebook and the second is the interpretations of the implied meaning of the texts in the Coursebook.

Pranoto (2013) conducted a study about Implicature Analysis in Maher Zain's song lyrics. The song lyrics were taken from Maher Zain's album entitled "Forgive Me". In this research, the researcher attempted to find the meaning of the lyrics used Implicature theory. The research used the descriptive qualitative method. The researcher of this research found the meaning of each song lyric and found the conversational Implicature (generalized and particularized) in the song lyrics.

Rahayu and Safnil (2016) did the study entitled Types of Implicature in Informal Conversations Used by The English Education Study Program Students. The researchers analyzed the types of Implicature found in the informal conversations between English education study program students. They took 25 students as their research subjects and then transcribed the informal conversations between the students using the checklist instrument. In this research, Rahayu and Safnil found out three types of Implicature found in informal conversations; conventional Implicature, generalized Implicature, and particularized conversational Implicature. The researchers concluded that there must be an implied meaning behind it in every informal conversation of the student.

From the previous studies above, the researcher can conclude that most of the studies above used Gricerian Implicature theory, and their data source are very diverse (movie, comic, coursebook, and so on). However, even though the previous studies have examined and explained in detail the Implicature and its type of their data source, just a few of them analyzed song lyrics that are important to analyze because songs nowadays are part of everyone's life and people cannot be separated from them. And most importantly, other researchers tend to analyze the whole album, but what makes this research more comprehensive than theirs is because my research is analyzing the song lyrics that are chosen from nine artists with different messages and meanings so the readers can get further knowledge and view. The reason why the researcher did not analyze the whole album from one artist is that one album from one artist tends to have the same concept (according to the concept of the album), and the song lyrics certainly should match the concept of the album and it makes the research not vary. In this study, the researcher will analyze the song lyrics that are chosen from nine artists. The song lyrics that the researcher has chosen are not just ordinary lyrics but meaningful and unique lyrics that somehow contain implied meanings. The unique lyrics mean that the lyrics contain words that are unusual. In this research, the researcher analyzed the implicatures found in song lyrics and the Implicature found in the listener's responses. The song lyrics that the researcher chose are Courage by Celine Dion, Lovely by Billie Eilish, Helium by Sia, Falling by Harry Styles, Back In The Water, and Where The Heart Is by HAEVN, Silence by Khalid, Homesick by Dua Lipa, Fools by Troye Sivan, and Birds by Imagine Dragons. The responses of the listeners will be taken from comments under the selected song's music videos on Youtube, and the criteria for selecting the

listener's comments is that it must include the comments which commenting about the song, their feeling after listening to the song, and other reactions that are related to the song. This research aims to give the readers information about the implied meaning of the selected song lyrics and the listener's responses and to find out what types of Implicature are found in the selected song lyrics and the listener's responses.

#### 1.2 Statements of the Problem

- 1. What is the implied meaning (Implicature) of each sentence of the selected song lyrics?
- 2. What types of implicatures are found in the selected foreign song lyrics?
- 3. What is the Implicature of the listener's responses about the songs?

#### 1.3 Significance of the Study

This research aims to give the readers information about the implied meaning of the selected song lyrics and to determine what types of Implicature are found in the selected song lyrics. The researcher expects that this research will be able to make the reader understand about Implicature and its types with the analysis that the researcher will do as the example. The researcher hopes that this research becomes the reference for other researchers who will analyze the same topic as this research.

#### 1.4 Scope and Limitation

This research focuses on the Implicature and its types found in each sentence of the selected song lyrics using Gricerian Implicature theory. This research limits at the data which are from the selected song lyrics, and the theory used in this research only focus on implicature theory, excluding the cooperation principle by Grice.

#### 1.5 Definition of Key Terms

- Implicature
  - Implicature is something beyond what the speaker literally says or can be said as a distinct meaning of an utterance.
- Song Lyric

Song lyric is the arrangement of words that build up a song, and it usually consists of choruses and verses.

#### **CHAPTER II**

#### REVIEW OF RELATED LITERATURE

#### 2.1 Implicature

Implicature is something beyond what the speaker of an utterance literally says. According to Yule (1996), Implicature is an additional conveyed meaning of utterances. Yule (1996) stated that implicatures are the basic example of a communicative utterance beyond what is said.

There are three types of Implicature; they are; Conversational Implicature, Conventional Implicature, and Scalar implicature.

#### 2.1.1 Conversational Implicature

According to Birner (1988), conversational Implicature connects to cooperative principle (Grice). Conversational Implicature has a contribution to the meaning of the utterance, which is not truth-conditional. It means that the Implicature is being held or not, it does not affect the truth of the statement. Conversational Implicature refers to the inference or assumption that a hearer creates regarding the intended meaning of a speaker that derives from their use of the actual meaning of what the speaker said, the conversational principle, and its maxims.

Example: When I say "there is nothing at the party" I do not mean 'nothing at all", but rather 'there is no something that I interested in the party'. The person I am talking to will assume this and implicate the actual meaning.

There are two types of conversational Implicature; Generalized conversational Implicature and Particularized conversational Implicature. According to Birner (1988), generalized conversational Implicature is one of Implicature which is generally attached to the form, and therefore does not need to be computed new with each relevant utterance. Generalized conversational Implicature is a conversational implicature that is inferable without reference to a special context. It is an inference that refers to the non-explicit meaning that automatically results in any type of context. Particularized conversational Implicature occurs when a conversation occurs in a very special context in which locally recognized inferences are assumed. Then, the use of particularized conversational Implicature typically intends to flout the maxims of quality, quantity, manner, and relevant.

#### 2.1.2 Conventional Implicature

Conventional Implicature is context-independent. According to Birner (1988), conventional Implicature does not require a calculation based on the maxims and the context, but they are consistently attached to a particular linguistic expression such as 'therefore', 'but', 'yet', 'even', and 'however', regardless of context. Conventional implicatures are connected with specific words and result in additional conveyed meanings when those words are used. In

conventional Implicature, the particular context is not required in order to obtain the Implicature.

Example: Mark Lee: Hey Liv, How if we go to the 'Spring Fling' together?

Livia: Well...actually...I am going with Jay

The use of 'well' here conventionally implicates that what the speaker is going to say is not what the hearer is expecting to hear.

#### 2.1.3 Scalar Implicature

Scalar implicature is greater detail of a particular sort of implicature expressing quantity and terms that are listed from the highest to the lowest value. When an individual uses a word from a set of words that express some kind of scale values, it is called a scalar implicature. Words such as 'all', 'most', 'something', 'many', 'few', 'nothing', 'some', 'sometimes', 'always', 'certain, 'possible', 'probable' and 'often' are the examples of this. The basic of scalar Implicature is that when any form in a scale is asserted, the negative of all forms higher on the scale is implicated.

Example: A: I help my mother in the shop sometimes.

The word 'sometimes' in the example above implicates that 'A' is not always help her mother in the shop.

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#### 2.2 Song Lyric

According to the Merriam-Webster dictionary, Song is a short musical and poetical composition of words and music. In a song, there must be a lyric to make it poetical. According to Literary Devices, Lyric is a collection of verses and choruses, build up a complete song or a short non-narrative poem. A lyric uses a single speaker who expresses personal emotions or thoughts. These days lyricists and musicians create lyrics that relate to any kind of issues in their surroundings. The term "lyric" originates from the Greek word "lyre" which is an instrument used by the Grecians to play when reading a poem.

Lyrics have essential contributions to the song itself. Lyrics give the listener of a song a deep understanding of the message implied in the song. A song listener can receive the message in a song lyric and apply the good ones in their lives.

#### **CHAPTER III**

#### **METHODOLOGY**

In this chapter, the researcher provided an explanation about the methodology of this research. It consists of research design, data collection, the technique of data collection, and data analysis.

#### 3.1 Research Design

In this research, the implicature theory becomes the central aspect of the research to answer the research problems. The researcher used the descriptive qualitative method to analyze the data.

The researcher focused on the implicatures found in the selected song lyrics.

The researcher explained the implicatures found in the selected song lyrics and wrote each sentence of the song lyrics and the analysis in the form of a table.

#### 3.2 Data Collection

#### 3.2.1 Data and Data Source

The data of this research are song lyrics that were selected from various artists and the listener's responses found in the comments under the selected song's music video on Youtube. The criteria of the song lyrics that the researcher analyzed are that the lyrics should have meaningful and unique lyrics (unique means that the lyrics contain unusual word choices/the lyrics that possibly convey explicit meaning). The source of the data was from the internet, which is known

as Google and Youtube. We can find the selected song lyrics by searching it on google search, and we can find the listener's responses from the comments under the selected song's music video. The researcher only took five listener's responses from each selected song's music video. The researcher searched the selected song lyrics, and the listener's responses on Google and Youtube, and then the researcher formed it into data. The song lyrics which pass the criteria that the researcher analyzed are Courage by Celine Dion, Lovely by Billie Eilish ft. Khalid, and Helium by Sia, Falling by Harry Styles, Back In The Water, and Where The Heart Is by HAEVN, Silence by Khalid, Homesick by Dua Lipa, Fools by Troye Sivan, and Birds by Imagine Dragons.

#### 3.2.2 Tools and Instrument

The main instrument of this research is the researcher to collect and analyze the data. The researcher became the main instrument because this research does not use the instrument like focus group discussion or questionnaire to collect the data. The researcher also used various tools to support the research such as laptop, smartphone, books, internet connection, and stationeries.

#### 3.2.3 Technique of Data Collection

These are the techniques that the researcher used to collect the data:

# 1. Search the Selected Song Lyric on Search Engine Called Google and Search the Listener's Responses of each Selected Song's Music Video on Youtube

The researcher typed, for example, "lovely by Billie Eilish ft. Khalid lyric" on the Google search button.

#### 2. Copy the Data to Microsoft Word

The researcher copied and pasted the selected song lyrics and the listener's responses to Microsoft Word.

#### 3.3 Data Analysis

These are the techniques that the researcher used for data analysis:

#### 1. Divided Each of The Selected Song Lyric into Sentences

After the researcher collects all of the data, the researcher started to analyze the data. Firstly, the researcher divided each of the selected song lyrics into sentences and then tabulated them.

### 2. Grouping the Listener's Responses from each Selected Songs and make it Into Sentences

After dividing the song lyrics into the sentence and tabulate them, the next step is grouping the listener's responses from each selected song and then make it into sentences.

#### 3. Analyze the Implicature and its Types of the Data

After divides the data into sentences and form them in the form of a table, the researcher found the implicatures and the types of Implicature found in the selected song lyrics placed in the discussion section. And for the listener's response, the analysis and the types of Implicature were placed beside the comment in the form of a table.

#### **CHAPTER IV**

#### FINDING AND DISCUSSION

This chapter discusses the analysis of the selected song's lyrics and the listener's responses regarding the songs using Grice's theory of Implicature and seeks what types of Implicature will be found out after analyzing all of the data.

#### 4.1 Findings

In this research, the form of the data is in the form of the lyrics. The findings are found by analyzing the Implicature of the sentence, words, or text in the song's lyrics.

#### 4.1.1 Implicature of Song Lyrics

#### Data 1

#### Homesick by Dua Lipa

From the song's title, we know that the song's mood is that the songwriter or singer tried to express his/her feeling of homesick. The lyric expresses how someone has been far away from someone to achieve dreams or anything else.

#### • Datum 1.1

**Song Lyrics:** Here, where the sky's falling

I'm covered in blue

I'm running and I'm crawling

Fighting for you

**Analysis:** This lyric means that this persona is somewhere at the place where she will achieve her dreams, and she feels unhappy because she had to separate from the one she loves but must survive even though it cost much of her life.

#### • Datum 1.2

**Song Lyrics:** When the rain stops, then, darling

What will I do

Analysis: In this lyric, the word 'rain' has an Implicature meaning.

It means the obstacle and the hardship that she faced in that place.

#### • Datum 1.3

**Song Lyrics:** You give me a reason, something to believe in **Analysis:** This lyric implicates a meaning which is the one who is loved by this persona gives her an explanation why she must do this and that. In other words, they give her strength.

#### • Datum 1.4

**Song Lyrics:** You give me a meaning, something I can breathe in

Analysis: This lyric pretty much has the same meaning as the

third data

#### • Datum 1.5

**Song Lyrics:** But I wish I was there with you

**Analysis:** This lyric implicates that she wants to be around her loved ones and this lyric represents how homesick she is.

#### • Datum 1.6

Somg Lyrics: When I'm walking on water

All my dreams have come true

**Analysis:** The phrase 'walking on water ' means to be able to do God-like or superhuman acts. In the case of this lyric, she does a great job that she has never done it before to achieve her dreams.

#### Data 2

#### Where the Heart Is by HAEVN

According to the songwriter, 'Where the Heart Is' is a song that the lyric tells about chasing our dreams, believing, and listening to our heart. The mood of this song is encouraging the listener to fall in at the deep end of our ways of chasing our dreams. According to the songwriter, a song is successful when someone recognizes themselves in it. Considering it to be easily digestible and that you wanted to tell true musical stories. And the songwriter thinks that it might be the combination of words and music at work that we can practically feel ourselves jumping in at the deep end in this song.

#### • Datum 2.1

**Song Lyrics:** High above the tallest tree

Courage will come your way

Analysis: This lyric implicates that when we finally take a step or on top to chase our dream, we will get courage out of nowhere, and suddenly we do not feel any doubt anymore because we do not ever get any courage if we never try it.

#### • Datum 2.2

**Song Lyrics:** When you climb out of the shade

Your high awakes the things you wanna be

Analysis: This lyric means when we could get out of our comfort zone and want to try new things, we can get everything we have dreamed of

#### • Datum 2.3

Song Lyrics: Take the leap of your life

As the ground is shaking

Shaking off your troubled soul

As silence seems to grow

It's the faith in sight, the doubt that fades

As the world dissolve below

Analysis: The lyrics in the third data of the second datum implicates that when you are in a way of chasing your dreams, no matter how hard, exhausting, confusing, and suffocating it, do not give up and keep going. All you have now is faith that keeps away the doubt and all the hard work and hardship will be paid of.

#### Data 3

#### **Back in the Water by HAEVN**

The songwriter said in the interview, "Back in the Water" is a song about a situation in which the person you are in a relationship with is not feeling well. It is as if she is underwater, she is out of reach. Though you know that everything will be alright if you decide to wait for her. You just need to wait for her to go for a while. This song is about conflict in intimacy. You are really close to somebody, but you cannot share that intimacy. You express your loyalty by making sure your lover knows you will give them time to get out of it.

#### • Datum 3.1

Song Lyrics: You are back in the rain, in over your head

Back in the deep, old things unsaid

Back in the water, we are back in the water

**Analysis:** The lyric in the first data of the third datum implicates something. As we know, the song informs about someone who is feeling unwell (in the aspect of mental) and it feels like she is

underwater and out of reach. Those lyrics implicate that someone he is in a relationship with is back to the state of depression as well as their relationship.

#### • Datum 3.2

Song Lyrics: I'm leaving a last call for your heart

Begging for so long

Won't you comeback in the water, back in the water

Analysis: In the second data, the Implicature of the lyric is like he gives her a choice to let her go and give her time to get rid of all of the water in order to save their relationship.

#### • Datum 3.3

**Song Lyrics:** The night fell slowly on our glory days

I like awake just to see you fade away

You're lost without a trace

**Analysis:** This lyric implicates that the songwriter literally enjoyed the time when were together but then after long time he feels that she is out of reach and kind of disappear.

#### • Datum 3.4

**Song Lyrics:** When you've washed away your sorrow

I'll be right here, 'til you ready for the road

**Analysis:** The lyric implicates that he will wait for her to recover and ready to work on their relationship once again.

#### Data 4

#### Helium by Sia

Helium is a song about the power and the strength that she gets from being in a relationship with her loved one. This song portrays gratefulness towards someone who is always around when she is in need and even in her lowest state.

#### • Datum 4.1

Song Lyrics: I never wanted to need someone

Analysis: This lyric has an Implicature meaning. It means, in the past she did not need someone in her life but time passes and she realizes that now she needs someone to be around in her life.

#### • Datum 4.2

**Song Lyrics:** Yeah, I wanted to play tough, thought I could do all this on my own

But even Superwoman sometimes needed Superman's soul

Analysis: This lyric implicates that previously she wanted to act
strong and she thought that she could do everything on her own
but now she is thinking that is not true, she cannot do everything
on her own. She needs someone to help her cope with everything.

She is referring to herself as a superwoman and she thinks that every woman needs a man figure.

#### • Datum 4.3

Song Lyrics: Help me out of this hell

**Analysis:** In the third data, the lyric implicates that right now she is in hell. "Hell" in here does not mean literal hell but rather a world that is cruel which feels like hell.

#### • Datum 4.4

Song Lyrics: Your love lifts me up when I'm down, down, down, when I've hit the ground

You're all I need

Analysis: This lyric means that everything she needs when she is in the lowest state of herself is the love from the man. The phrase "when I've hit the ground' here implicates that she has been through hardship and being on the low many times.

#### • Datum 4.5

**Song Lyrics:** I'm stronger 'cause you fill me up

**Analysis:** This lyric implicates that she is not strong or weak when the man does not fill her up

#### • Datum 4.6

**Song Lyrics:** I am lucky that you're around

**Analysis:** The lyric implicates that she is grateful that he is around and she thinks that she is unlucky when he is not around

#### Data 5

#### **Courage by Celine Dion**

Courage is a song about losing people. According to the singer, "Courage" is not just a song but is an emotion and a language. # 4.1.2 The Types of Implicature Found in The Selected Song Lyrics

In this discussion of the types of Implicature, the researcher provides the process of analyzing and identifying the lyrics from the selected songs in order to

classify it into the types of Implicature whether it is a conversational implicature (generalized and particularized conversational Implicature), conventional implicature, and scalar implicature.

# 4.1.2.1 Generalized Conversational Implicature

Generalized conversational implicatures are inferences that refer to the non-explicit meaning that occurs automatically in any type of context (Grice, 1975). It is inferable without reference without reference to a special context.

According to the explanation above, the researcher has found data which match with the explanation about generalized conversational Implicature. As in data 2 and 9 from the utterance "High above the tallest tree, Courage will come your way" and "Yeah, I rather be a lover than a fighter, cause all my life I've been fighting", the contexts that the songs bring do not influence the utterance which produced by the speakers because it can stand by itself and it does not requires specific contexts.

## 4.1.2.2 Particularized Conversational Implicature

Particularized conversational Implicature is an implicature where some assumed knowledge is required in a specific context in an utterance.

Based on the explanation above, the researcher has found data which require very specific context, as in data 3, 4, and 6 from the utterances "You are back in the rain, in over your head, back in the deep old things unsaid, back in the water", "help me out of this hell", and "And my hopes they are high I must keep them small, though I try to resist I still want it all", all of these utterances require

specific contexts. The word "hell" on that utterance does not mean literal hell but "hell' here means life that is going really bad so it tastes like hell. The context is required here in order to understand what the speaker tries to imply.

# **4.1.2.3** Conventional Implicature

In contrast to conversational Implicature which is context-dependent,

Conventional Implicature is context-independent. Conventional Implicature does

not require a calculation based on the context and the maxims but it is consistently

attached to particular linguistic expression or conjunctions regardless of context.

Based on the explanation about conventional Implicature above, the researcher has found data that match with the explanation above as in the data 1, 4, 7, and 9. In the data 1, the utterance "But I wish I was there with you" consists of the linguistic expression "but" which implicates a sense of counter-expectation. In the data 4, the utterance "yeah I wanted to play tough, thought I could do all this on my own but even superwoman sometimes needed superman's soul" consist of the conjunction "but" which implicates a sense of contrast between being tough and needed someone. In the data 7, the utterance "even if it takes all night or a hundred years" consists of linguistic expression "even" which means being okay whether it takes all night or hundred years. In the data 9, the utterance "love only left me alone but I'm at one with the silence" consists the conjunction "but" which implicates a sense of contrast between the love that left him alone and him who at one with the silence.

# **4.1.2.4 Scalar Implicature**

Scalar implicature is an implicature when an individual uses a word that expresses quantity and some kind of scale values. When producing an utterance, a speaker selects the word from the scale which is more informative.

According to the explanation above, the researcher has found data that suitable, as in data 5 and 10. In the data 5, there is an utterance "sometimes it drowns me 'til I can't breathe". The word "sometimes" expresses scale of value which implicates that it is not always drown her. In the data 10, the utterance "some nights I think of you" contains the word "some" that expresses scale of value.

#### 4.2 Discussion

As presented in the findings above, the researcher concludes that the song lyrics have implicature meanings. The result in findings were shown that the generalized and particularized is the most frequent type found in the song lyrics and the listener's responses followed by the conventional and then scalar implicature. Those types (Conventional amd Scalar) do not always occur in an utterance so that is why they become the least types found in the song lyrics and the listener's responses. Implicature is something beyond what the speaker of an utterance says or implicit meaning of an utterance. It occurs when the speakers produce the implicit meanings so that it can be called as Implicature.

The implicatures found in the song lyrics and the listener's responses shows how the implicature is carried in the song lyrics (utterances). The least type of implicature found in the song lyrics and the listener's responses is Conventional Implicature. The characteristic of conventional implicature (the use particular linguistic expressions) indicates that conventional implicature is carried on both data. The linguistic expression such as "but", "however", and "even" is

used to indicate the characteristic of conventional implicature. The second least type found is Scalar Implicature. The characteristic or the feature of scalar implicature (the use of set of word that express some kind of scale values) indicates that scalar implicature is carried in the song lyrics as well as in the listener's responses. The characteristic of scalar implicature is indicated by the use of set of words that express scale values suc as "sometimes", "all", and "most".

The special or particular contexts are the detail information or the description of the songs. Those contexts are required to indicate the particularized conversational implicature in the song lyrics and the listener's responses.

Finally, the analysis of implicature and its types in the song lrics and the listener's responses were based on the characteristic attached to each types of implicature. Although the data seems to best fit in the data which contain conversations but different experimental data such as song lyrics and methods, would be required to reveal how vast Implicature is.

## **CHAPTER V**

# CONCLUSION AND SUGGESTION

In this chapter, the researcher provides a conclusion of the study and the suggestion for future researches.

#### 5.1 Conclusion

After analyzing all the data, the researcher found that all of the types of Implicature were found in the selected song lyrics and as well as in the listener's responses. The most frequent types that were found after analyzed the whole data are Generalized conversational Implicature and Particularized conversational Implicature. The researcher only found 6 Conventional implicature and 4 Scalar Implicature in the whole data (the song lyrics and the listener's responses).

## 5.2 Suggestion

The present study tries to seek the Implicature and its types on the selected song lyrics and listener's responses. This study is dedicated to contribute in analyzing the Implicature not only in the novel, film, script, comic and et cetera but in the song lyric that people rarely thinking about.

The researcher suggests for the future researchers to put interest in this scope of pragmatics study (Implicature) and to explore more about what to analyze beside novel, film, comic, movie script, and song lyrics.

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
