
CHAPTER 5

CONCLUSION

After answering the question of the research problems in the previous study, then the conclusions and the suggestion will be presented in this chapter.

5.1 Conclusion

After having analyzed the following data, the conclusion of the research is the language variety used by the characters in Downy Runway Dreams can be categorized as a register because they used certain terminology based on the topic. Their terminologies of their language are used and understood by people in same occupation. Most of the terms they used are adapted from English and the other are from Indonesia language. The characters mixed between English and Indonesia language but the main language is English. We can see such as proverb below:

The registers used by the characters are divided into words and phrase categories. The first is register in words are noun, verb, adjective and adverb. Then for phrase are verb phrase and noun phrase.

Moreover there are four factors influencing registers used by characters. Those factors are participant, setting and situational context, topic of the conversation, and the function for the interaction. In term of participant, the characters use their register among to their community. They use those registers communicate with people who have the same occupation, interest, and activities. In term of situational context, the register use by the characters depends on what situations happening, such as formal and informal situations. Formal situations usually in office and fashion show venue and informal situations in park and home. Furthermore, topic of the conversation is also related to the fashion world such as: fashion item, fashion show, theme, dress, etc. last is the term of the function of interaction described the function of each conversation during their activity.

There are two kinds of acts that are related to the function of interaction in their conversation. First is locutionary act refers to the actual meaning of the utterance, second is illocutionary act refers to request someone to do something based on the utterance.
