

CHAPTER III

ANALYSIS

In this chapter, the researcher wants to analyze the element of characterization as seen Ron's Family in J.K Rowling's novel. In Ron's Family they are Mrs. Weasley, Mr. Weasley, the Twin, Ginny and Ron.
