

**RACISM TOWARDS BLACK PEOPLE DEPICTED IN TWO SELECTED
ADJEI-BRENYAH'S SHORT STORIES**

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ABSTRACT

This study aims to analyze the similarities and the differences of the depiction of racism from two selected short stories by Adjei-Brenyah, *Finkelstein 5* and *Zimmer Land*. The researcher brings this topic because both Adjei-Brenyah's short stories illustrates the portrayal of racism in a different way. Both works also presents regarding how the main characters have to deal with the racism they encounter and how the racism changes them. There are three questions to be analyzed in this study: (1) How is racism depicted in two Adjei-Brenyah's short stories, *Finklestein 5* and *Zimmer Land*? (2) How do the main characters in both stories deal with the racism? (3) How are the similarities and differences of two topics asked in prior questions

This research utilizes the qualitative method to gather the required data for the analysis. The researcher also uses the comparison-contrast approach along with close reading approach to analyze the similarities and the differences found in both short stories. Critical race theory is used to analyzed how is racism depicted in both short stories. While, new criticism theory is used so that the researcher could analyzed all the data through sentences, dialogues and words provided in the literary works.

This research finds that there are similarities and differences in the depiction of racism from both short stories by using the basic tenet of critical race theory. In *Finkelstein 5*, there are two basic tenets analyzed from the story, they are social construction and everyday racism. While in *Zimmer Land*, there are also two basic tenets analyzed from the story, they are material determinism and everyday racism. The researcher also finds that the main character from both stories deal with racism differently. In *Finkelstein 5*, racism causes the main character to be a round character, which means he changes throughout the story. While in *Zimmer Land*, racism causes the main character to be a flat character, which means that he stays the same throughout the story. In conclusion, the researcher finds that both stories have similarity in one basic tenet, which is everyday racism. It is because main character from both stories has to experience racism in daily basis. Meanwhile, the researcher also finds two differences. The first is that the racism happens in both stories are in the different type and for the second is how both of the main character deal with racism.

ABSTRAK


Studi ini bertujuan untuk menganalisis persamaan dan perbedaan atas penggambaran rasisme dari dua cerita pendek terpilih karya Adjei-Brenyah, Finkelstein 5 dan Zimmer Land. Peneliti membawa topik ini dikarenakan kedua karya tulis Adjei-Brenyah ini mengilustrasikan penggambaran racism dalam cara yang menarik dan juga modern. Kedua karyanya juga mempersempit tentang bagaimana para karakter utama harus menghadapi rasisme yang mereka temui dan bagaimana rasisme dapat mengubah mereka. Setidaknya, ada tiga pertanyaan yang dianalisa dalam studi ini: (1) Bagaimana rasisme digambarkan dalam dua cerita pendek karya Adjei-Brenyah? (2) Bagaimana karakter utama dari kedua cerita menghadapi rasisme yang mereka alami? (3) Bagaimana kesamaan dan perbedaan dari 2 topik yang sudah ditanyakan sebelumnya?

Riset ini menggunakan metode kualitatif untuk mengumpulkan data-data yang dibutuhkan untuk analisis. Peneliti juga menggunakan pendekatan perbandingan-kontras bersamaan dengan teknik baca cermat untuk menganalisis persamaan dan perbedaan yang ditemukan dalam kedua cerita. Teori *critical race* digunakan untuk menganalisa rasisme dari kedua cerita. Teori *New Criticism* digunakan agar peneliti bisa menganalisa semua data melalui kalimat, dialog, dan juga kata-kata yang tersedia dalam karya tulis tersebut.

Riset ini menemukan ada kesamaan dan perbedaan dalam penggambaran rasisme dari kedua cerita dengan menggunakan *basic tenet* dari *critical race theory*. Dalam *Finkelstein 5*, ada dua *basic tenet* yang dianalisa, mereka adalah *social construction* dan *everyday racism*. Sedangkan dalam *Zimmer Land*, juga ditemukan dua *basic tenet* yang teranalisa, mereka adalah *material determinism* dan *everyday racism*. Peneliti juga menemukan bahwa kedua karakter utama menghadapi rasisme dengan cara yang berbeda. Dalam *Finkelstein 5*, rasisme menyebabkan si karakter utama untuk menjadi *round character*, yang dimana si karakter harus berubah sepanjang cerita. Sedangkan dalam *Zimmer Land*, rasisme menyebabkan si karakter utama menjadi *flat character*, yang berarti ia tetap sama sepanjang cerita. Kesimpulannya, peneliti menemukan bahwa kedua cerita memiliki kesamaan dalam satu *basic tenet*, yaitu *everyday racism*. Itu disebabkan oleh karakter utama dari kedua cerita yang mengalami rasisme dalam aktivitasnya sehari-hari. Sementara itu, peneliti juga menemukan dua perbedaan. Yang pertama adalah rasisme yang terjadi dalam kedua cerita memiliki tipe yang berbeda

dan perbedaan yang kedua adalah tentang bagaimana kedua karakter utama menghadapi rasisme.

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
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
