## ABSTRACT

**Eriany, Chinthia Putri.** “*The Role of the Hebrew Immigrant Aid Society (HIAS) Pennsylvania and Oak Foundation in International Migrant Empowerment in the City of Philadelphia for the 2022-2023*”. Islamic State University of Sunan Ampel Surabaya. 2024

*This research aims to describe how the role of HIAS Pennsylvania and Oak Foundation in empowering the international migrant in the City of in 2022-2023. While many NGOs local offer pro-immigrant programs, HIAS Pennsylvania is expanding its partnership with the Oak Foundation and implementing it through three major programs: Arrival Citizenship, Social Services, and Legal Services. According to the author, this initiative exemplifies the role of INGOs in terms of education, agency, development capacity, resources, and sustainability. The research uses a qualitative and descriptive approach. We collected the data through an interview with Cathryn Miller-Wilson, the Executive Director of HIAS Pennsylvania, and other documentation. The results show that the program that the program handed out by HIAS Pennsylvania show that the role of INGO is aligned with the five empowerment mechanisms, such as education service providers (knowledge), organizational agencies, development capacity, resources, and sustainability.*

Penelitian ini bertujuan untuk memaparkan peran dari HIAS Pennsylvania dan *Oak Foundation* dalam melakukan pemberdayaan terhadap migran internasional di Kota Philadelphia pada tahun 2022-2023. Meskipun telah banyak INGO dan LSM lokal yang memiliki program yang pro-imigran, namun HIAS Pennsylvania mengekskansi kerja samanya dengan *Oak Foundation* dan diwujudkan melalui tiga program utama, yaitu, *Arrival Citizenship*, *Social Services* dan *Legal Services*. Penulis berargumen bahwa program tersebut merupakan wujud dari peran INGO yang berada dalam aspek pendidikan, agensi, kapasitas pembangunan, sumber daya dan keberlanjutan. Penelitian ini menggunakan metode pendekatan kualitatif dan pendekatan deskriptif. Kemudian, teknik pengumpulan data yang dilakukan adalah wawancara dengan *Executive Director* dari HIAS Pennsylvania, Cathryn Miller-Wilson dan dokumentasi. Hasil penelitian menunjukkan bahwa program yang dijalankan oleh HIAS Pennsylvania menunjukkan lima peran INGO yang sesuai dengan mekanisme pemberdayaan, yaitu, layanan pendidikan, agensi organisasi, kapasitas pembangunan, sumber daya, dan keberlanjutan.

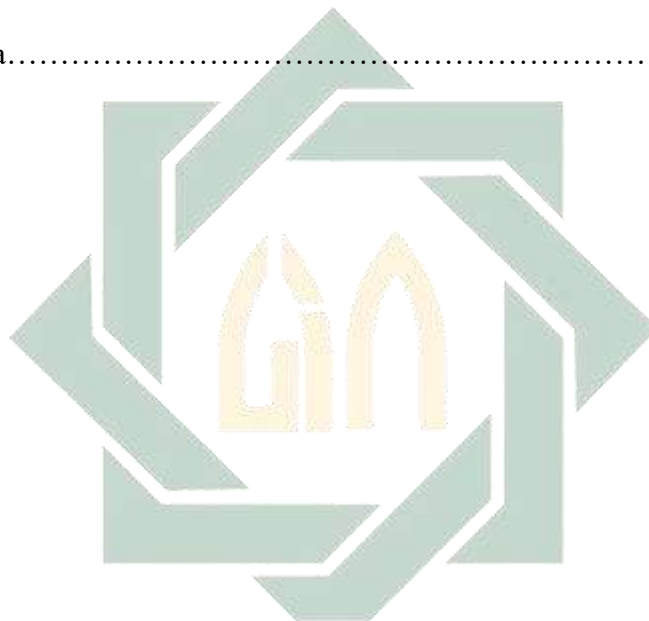

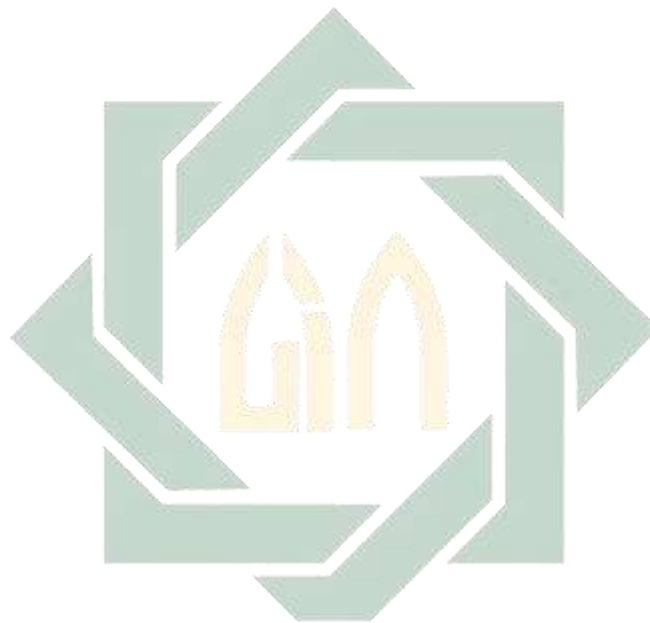

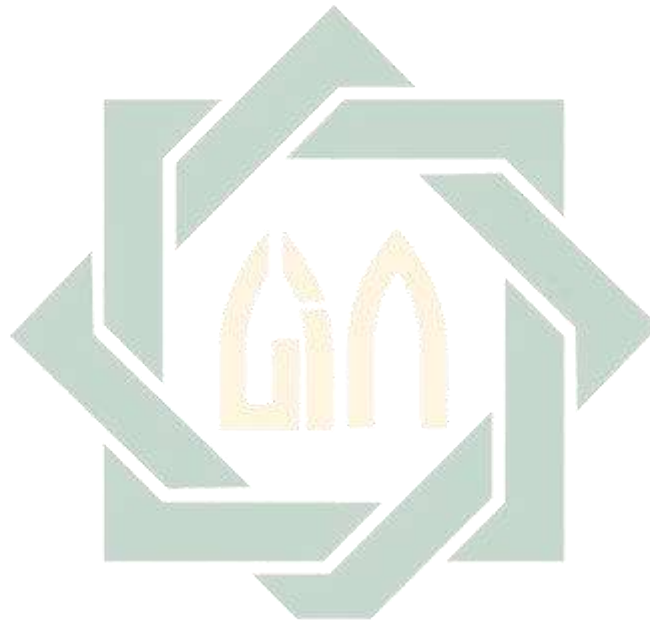
