CONCLUSION

It was also recommended that the next researchers can use the Grice's maxims to conduct the research on the other areas. The data used in this research was limited for Elizabeth, thus the researcher suggests to enlarge more data when analyze it in

order to make it clearer. In addition, the researcher also suggests to the next researchers to use other relevance theory to explore different topics in the same area of the research.
