## **CHAPTER V**

## CONCLUSION AND SUGGESTION

## **5.1 Conclusion**

Ed Sheeren is one of the success younger singer and composer from United Kingdom. He got many awards because his works that accepted by the listeners. His song is mostly about love, loyalty and expectation. He showed his genius and unique by writing the interesting topic in his songs. Songs is kind of language that says more and more intensely that the ordinary language does. It is one of the examples of literary work. It has its own characteristic and unique style that also represent the characteristic and the style of the composer. One of the characteristic songs is using figure of speech. A composer usually uses figure of speech in order to make a deep and great meaning.

From the discussion explained in the previous chapter, it can be concluded. There are much kind of figure of speech and implicit meaning that used in Ed Sheeren's selected song. It uses figure of speech by Perrine's theory.

1. The most figures of speech found in this song are symbol, simile, metaphors, personification, hyperbole, metonymy and synecdoche. From the five songs they are, Photograph, thinking out loud, kiss me, Lego house and don't, it can concludes the implicit meanings of figure of speech in Ed Sheeren's selected songs are about love, loyalty, expectation, opportunity, sadness, pleasure, believe. The writer concludes that there are

four figures of speech that used in 'Photograph' song. They are metaphor, personification, synecdoche and hyperbole. There are four metaphors, two personifications, four synecdoche and three hyperboles. In the 'Thinking out loud' there are four figure of speech. They are metaphor, simile, hyperbole and symbol. There are two metaphors, one simile, two hyperboles and two symbols. In the 'Kiss me' there are four figure of speech. They are metonymy, metaphor, simile and hyperbole. There are one metonymy, one metaphor, three similes and two hyperboles. In the 'Lego house' there are three figures of speech. They are symbol, personification and hyperbole. There are one symbol, two personifications and three hyperboles. In the 'Don't' there are three figure of speech. There are symbol, simile and metaphor. There are one symbol, two similes and two metaphors.

2. The writer find nine metaphors, six similes, four personifications, four synecdoche, one metonymy, four symbols and seven hyperboles that appear in Ed Sheeren selected songs. In this study the writer also found that metaphor is the most used by Ed Sheeren in these five songs.

## 5.2 Suggestion

In this study the writer revealed two statement of problem on figure of speech; kind and meaning of figure of speech, and the mostly figure of speech used in Ed Sheeren's selected song. For next researcher who want to understand

about the types of figure of speech and the meaning of it. The researcher has some recommendations, as follow:

- 1. There are still many objects that can be analyzed such as poem, prose, drama, magazine, newspaper, and novel, comic and other. The next researcher can use this object to find the types of figure of speech.
- 2. For the next researcher, to find the meaning it can use many kinds of dictionary or interpret the meaning by look the background of the song or other object by look the biography of the composer so we can image or get the meaning of the type of figure of speech. The next researcher must read and listen regularly the object to get feel the meaning or what the message of the object.

And from this research the writer hopes that her study can give benefits to other researcher in stylistic field.
