3.2.3. Research Procedure

The data of this research had been collected from the novel of Harper Lee entitled "*To Kill a Mockingbird*". The novel consists of 31 chapters. For getting the analysis, the researcher looked for the utterance, word, and sentence in the part of racial injustice issue in the novel. First, the researcher read the whole text of *To Kill a Mockingbird* novel. After that, the researcher collected the data by underlining the part of racial injustice issue.

3.3. Technique of Data Analysis

The writer used descriptive qualitative techniques in analyze the data. This technique is applied to analyze the social context and the reproduction of racial injustice through the structure of the text of *To Kill a Mockingbird* novel based on the critical discourse analysis proposed by Teun A. van Dijk. First, the writer analyzed the utterance, word, and sentence in the part of racial injustice issue in the novel through the structure of the text (macrostructure, superstructure, and microstructure) of *To Kill a Mockingbird* novel based on the critical discourse analysis spearheaded by Teun A. van Dijk. Second, the writer analyzed the social context of Harper Lee's *To Kill a Mockingbird* novel.
