

ABSTRACT

Lestari, Dian. “Uzbekistan’s National Interest in Providing Foreign Aid to Afghanistan After the Taliban Takeover.” *Sunan Ampel State Islamic University, Surabaya, 2025*

This study analyzes Uzbekistan's national interests in providing foreign aid to Afghanistan after the Taliban takeover, using Donald E. Nuechterlein's concept of national interest. The results show that Uzbekistan has two main interests, namely security and economy, with different intensities. Security interests are categorized as a vital issue because threats from extremist groups such as ISIS-K and IMU can disrupt national stability if not addressed. Meanwhile, economic interests are categorized as a major issue, considering Afghanistan's role in Uzbekistan's infrastructure and trade projects in the Central Asia-South Asia region. By providing humanitarian aid, Uzbekistan seeks to maintain regional stability and build diplomatic relations with the Taliban to ensure the security of its borders and strengthen economic connectivity. Therefore, Uzbekistan's foreign aid is not only a humanitarian act, but also a diplomatic strategy to protect its national interests.

ABSTRAK

Penelitian ini menganalisis kepentingan nasional Uzbekistan dalam pemberian bantuan luar negeri kepada Afghanistan pasca pengambilalihan kekuasaan oleh Taliban, dengan menggunakan konsep kepentingan nasional Donald E. Nuechterlein. Hasil penelitian menunjukkan bahwa Uzbekistan memiliki dua kepentingan utama, yaitu keamanan dan ekonomi, dengan intensitas yang berbeda. Kepentingan keamanan dikategorikan sebagai *vital issue* karena ancaman dari kelompok ekstremis seperti ISIS-K dan IMU dapat mengganggu stabilitas nasional jika tidak ditangani. Sementara itu, kepentingan ekonomi dikategorikan sebagai *major issue*, mengingat peran Afghanistan dalam proyek infrastruktur dan perdagangan Uzbekistan di kawasan Asia Tengah-Asia Selatan. Dengan memberikan bantuan kemanusiaan, Uzbekistan berupaya menjaga stabilitas regional dan membangun hubungan diplomatik dengan Taliban guna memastikan keamanan perbatasannya serta memperkuat koneksi ekonomi. Oleh karena itu, bantuan luar negeri Uzbekistan bukan hanya tindakan kemanusiaan, tetapi juga strategi diplomasi untuk melindungi kepentingan nasionalnya.


